<p>Climate</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Breeding location is in Southern California in a hot, dry climate ▪ Produces best yields in warm/hot growing environments with Zero chilling required 	<p>Season</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Early California is widely regarded as the earliest commercially available asparagus hybrid ▪ Grown under tunnels, the season can be brought even further forward
<p>Hybrid Type</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Clonal hybrid ▪ F1 type ▪ Seed production takes place in an isolated growing location 	<p>Market</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Early California is suited to all asparagus market types in both green and white production ▪ The fresh market is its most common use but it can also be used for processing
<p>Yield</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Early California produces high yields ▪ It is a precocious variety with a high proportion of production early in the season 	<p>Quality</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The spears are of excellent quality with very tight tips ▪ Maintains high standards in hot climatic conditions
<p>Agronomy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ It is normally grown at high plant populations to ensure ideal production levels ▪ 35.000 – 40.000 crowns per hectare would be standard practice at a depth of 15cm 	<p>The Offer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Certified F1 seeds ▪ List of crown producers available on request ▪ Technical support package to extract the maximum benefit from the hybrid
